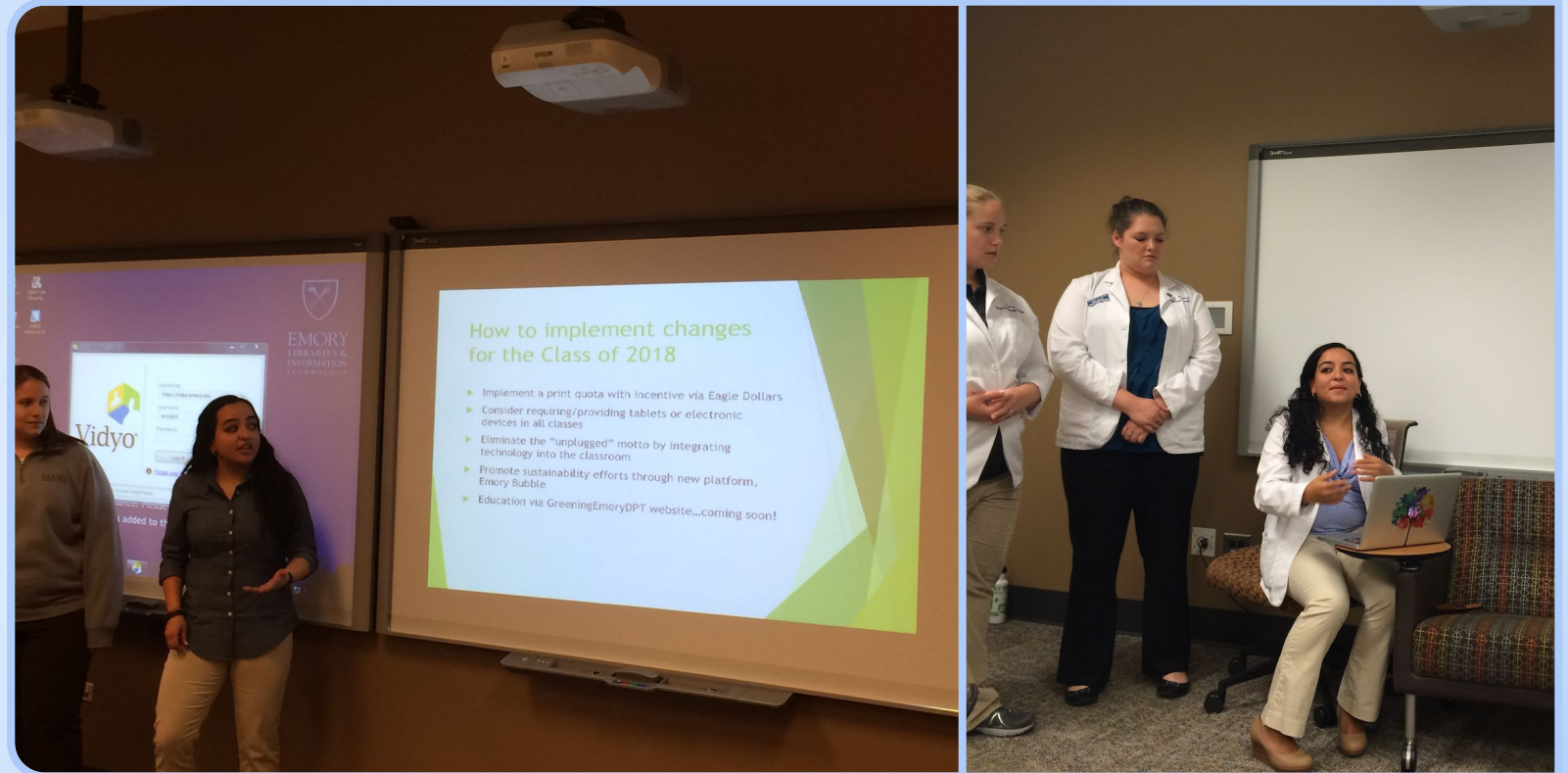

U.S. Healthcare Statistics

- In the USA, 10% of greenhouse gases are attributed to the healthcare system
- 9% of respiratory disease, 12% of acid rain and 10% of smog are from healthcare sector pollution
- Estimated to reduce 470,000 DALY, which is equivalent to 44,000 to 95,000 deaths per year with a cost of \$17 billion-\$29 billion per year (5%-8% of healthcare spending) Source: Eckelman and Sherman, 2016

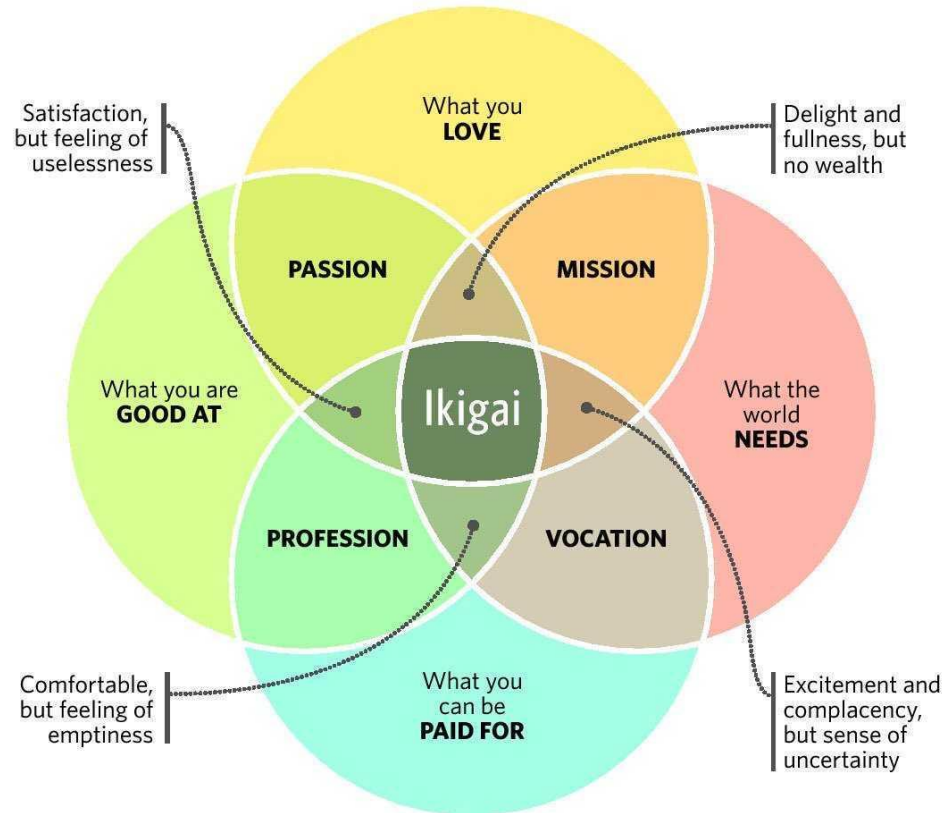
